



Fig S1. Effects of vortioxetine treatment on cell proliferation in non-cancerous cells

HUVEC stands for Human Umbilical Vein Endothelial Cells, which are endothelial cells extracted from the lining of the human umbilical vein within the umbilical cord. HUVEC Cells were treated with increasing concentrations of vortioxetine, and cell proliferation was assessed at 72 hours using the CCK8 assay.
